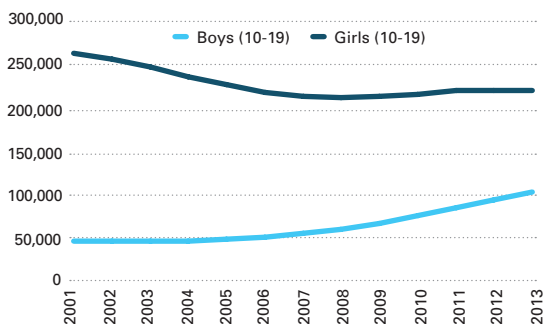


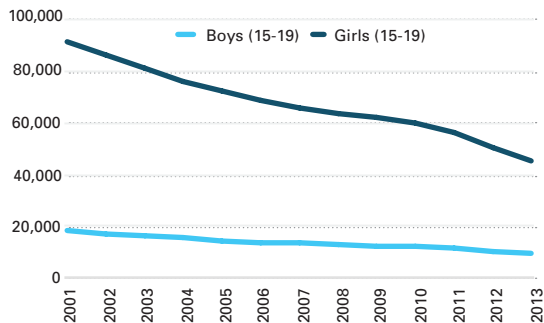

Adolescents (aged 10-19) living with HIV, 2001-2013⁴

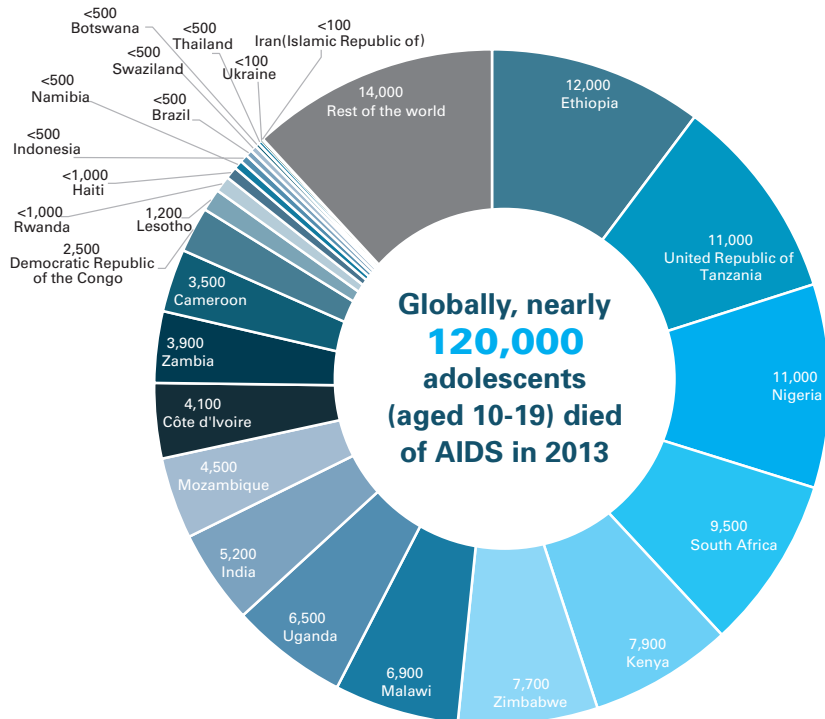


Adolescents (aged 15-19) newly infected with HIV, 2001-2013⁴



DISTRIBUTION OF ADOLESCENT AIDS-RELATED DEATHS

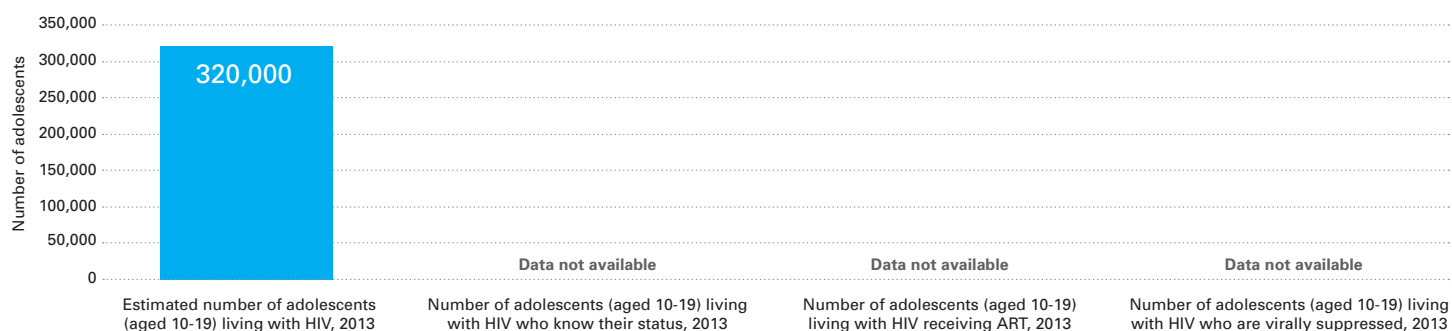
Estimated AIDS-related deaths among adolescents (aged 10-19), globally, 2013⁴
